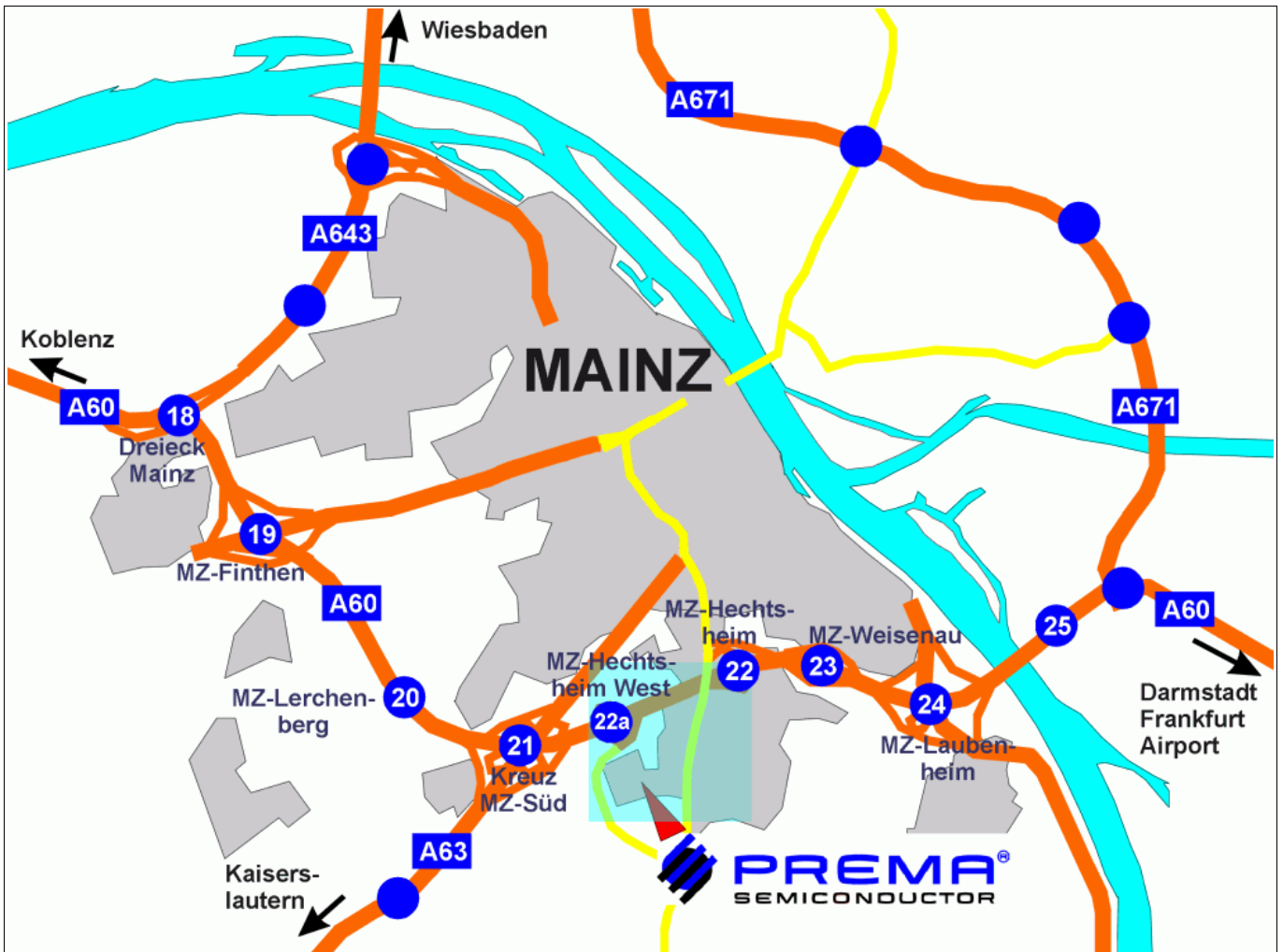


## Travel Directions to PREMA

PREMA is located in the industrial area of Mainz-Hechtsheim, about 35 km to the west of Frankfurt, within the Rhine-Main area. We can easily be reached by plane (via continental Europe's largest airport, Frankfurt), by car or by train.



### **Driving from Frankfurt Airport, or from North/Northeast (Hannover, Berlin, Nürnberg )**

Leave the Frankfurt airport area in the direction of Köln/Mainz (A3). Follow the signs on the A3 to Mainz. You will reach the A60 via the A67. Leave the A60 at exit no. 22a "Mainz-Hechtsheim-West" - this is the fourth exit after crossing the river Rhine.

\*) Coming from the highway, turn left at the third traffic lights "Gewerbegebiet Einfahrt E" (drive E) = Robert-Bosch-Str.. After about 700 m, PREMA is the large brown brick building on the left side (No. 6).

### **Driving from South/Southeast (München, Stuttgart, Basel)**

Coming from Darmstadt via the A67 until "Autobahndreieck Rüsselsheim". Change over to the A60. Leave the A60 at exit no. 22a "Mainz-Hechtsheim-West" - this is the fourth exit after crossing the river Rhine. Proceed as described above \*)

### **Driving from the Northwest (Brussels, Amsterdam, Köln)**

Use the A61 until "Autobahnkreuz Bingen". Change over to the A60, passing "Autobahndreieck Mainz" and "Autobahnkreuz Mainz", until exit no. 22a "Mainz-Hechtsheim-West". Proceed as described above \*).

### **Driving from the South/Southwest (Paris, Kaiserslautern, Strasbourg)**

Use the A63. At the "Autobahnkreuz Mainz" change to the A60, direction Darmstadt. Leave the A60 at exit no. 22a "Mainz-Hechtsheim-West.". Proceed as described above \*).

### **From the Frankfurt Airport by Taxi**

Trip takes about 20 to 30 minutes. Danger of traffic jams during rush hours. Fare approx. 45 €

### **From the Frankfurt Airport by Train**

Inside the airport building, follow the train signs to the subway level. Buy a ticket to "Mainz Hbf." at the "RMV" ticket machine (if in doubt, seek assistance at the information counter), fare about 3,50 €. Take the S-Bahn (city train) line S8 (not S9!) in the direction of Wiesbaden via Mainz (every 30 minutes during the day; trip takes about 30 minutes). Intercity (IC or EC) trains to or via Mainz are also possible, but subject to surcharge. Leave at "Mainz Hauptbahnhof" (main station).

From here you can use tram lines 50 or 51, direction "Hechtsheim/Bürgerhaus" (every 15 minutes), leave at "Mühdreieck,", cross the main road and walk about 300 m along Robert-Bosch-Street.

Alternatively, take bus line 66, direction "Ebersheim/Zornheim" to the bus stop "Mühdreieck" (Robert-Bosch-Street is the exit to the right), or before 8:45 a.m. to stop "Robert-Bosch-Str./TÜV,", diagonally across from PREMA.

### **Mainz is connected to the Fast Train Net (IC/EC/ICE) of the German Railway and is easy to reach.**

#### **From Mainz Main Station by Taxi**

Trip takes 10 to 15 minutes. Fare 12 to 14 €

#### **From Mainz Main Station by Tram or Bus**

Buy a ticket at the ticket machine or pay the driver. You can use tram lines 50 or 51, direction "Hechtsheim/Bürgerhaus" (every 15 minutes), leave at "Mühdreieck,", cross the main road and walk about 300 m along Robert-Bosch-Street.

Alternatively, take bus line 66, direction "Ebersheim/Zornheim" to the bus stop "Mühdreieck" (Robert-Bosch-Street is the exit to the right), or before 8:45 a.m. to stop "Robert-Bosch-Str./TÜV,", diagonally across from PREMA.
