

Statement of Conformity with REACH and RoHS for PREMA Semiconductor Products

PREMA accepts its responsibility to protect the environment by choosing environmentally friendly production methods and substances used in the production process.

REACH Compliance

PREMA Semiconductor acknowledges the impact of EU regulation Nr. 1907/2006 („REACH regulation“) on its products (wafers, unpackaged or packaged ICs.)

PREMA does not produce nor directly import chemicals. It is anticipated that substances used in electronic products will be registered by raw material manufacturers within the supply chain. Therefore, registration does not apply to PREMA semiconductor products.

PREMA products are "articles" as defined in REACH Article 3(3) and do not release substances under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use.

Substances of very high concern (SVHC) presently covered by REACH (as of 12 January 2017) are not contained in their products in concentrations above 0.1% on article level.

RoHS Compliance

All products delivered by PREMA generally comply with EU directive 2011/65/EU („RoHS“), if not stated otherwise.

In exceptional cases and only by customer's explicit consent, packages which are plated with Pb containing materials or containing other materials restricted by RoHS will be clearly marked as such. In these cases customer is responsible to use such products only for applications exempted from RoHS.
